	UNFPA Maldives country office has rolled out its 7th Country Programme Document (CPD) for 2022-2026 which defines the strategic outputs that UNFPA will prioritize in the Maldives over the next 5 years - including <i>family planning, youth empowerment, gender equality and population matters.</i>
	In November 2022, the world would reach 8 Billion in population - in tandem to this the Maldivian population is expected to grow - UNFPA highlights the <i>need to reduce inequalities and provide rights and choices for everyone, leaving no one behind.</i>
	It is within this context that UNFPA Maldives seeks a qualified graphic design firm to design and create a branded journal / notebook to disseminate key information on our advocacy and as an organization - with a unique, eye-catching and true-to-agency design.
Scope of work: (Description of services, activities, or outputs)	The firm will be required to create the design and layout of a professional journal / notebook to convey UNFPA's core branding in relation to the country context.
