Purpose of consultancy:	UNFPA, the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), is an international development agency that works to deliver a world where every pregnancy is wanted, every child birth is safe and every young person's potential is fulfilled. UNFPA supports government and other institutions to build their capacity on Life Skills Education and to create opportunities for adolescents and Young people, on issues that affect their Development and overall wellbeing. The purpose of this consultancy is to train facilitators from selected shelters and Family and Children Service Centers on Life skills based Reproductive Health Education (LSBRHE). Trained facilitators from this training is expected to orient and impart the skills to the children and women as per the Gender Equality Action Plan covering issues around psychosocial, interpersonal competencies and skills and an overall understanding of the Reproductive health needs of individuals at State Care. In this context, UNFPA Maldives is looking for a qualified individual to design and deliver a comprehensive and culturally relevant 5-day life skills-based Reproductive Health Education facilitators training for staff working at state care shelters to build their capacity to develop essential life skills to creatively engage with and work constructively with the children in state care vulnerable children.
